
EQUIPPING STUDENTS TO MAKE HEALTHY CHOICES

Can you imagine being a teenager during COVID? The stress and challenges our youth are facing in these times of uncertainty are daunting. Every student deserves to know they are valuable, worth protecting and worth respecting.

Sixth grade, middle school and high schools students across South Central Indiana participate in *I Decide For Me*. Because of your support, students learn to recognize their value and make decisions which reflect that value. Other organizations outside our region also purchase the *I Decide for Me* curriculum to equip their area youth with these vital life lessons.

Additionally, area churches host faith-based programs *Transformed* and *My Best for You*. With your support, teens and their parents/guardians are equipped to have crucial conversations based in faith about their value and God's design for sexuality.

RACHEL'S STORY

Rachel* recently participated in the *I Decide For Me* education program. At the end of the program, Rachel shared, "I want to thank you... you have done so much for me. I was sex trafficked and my self worth was non-existent before this Monday. I was convinced that since my virginity was taken against my will I was less of a human. I look in the mirror... and all I can think of is how many people have seen my body. My experience took away the meaning behind sex and love. I began to willingly have sex with people to feel loved and beautiful. **Now I know better. Anyone who loves my body before my soul will never love me the way I should be loved.** I have been through years of therapy, foster care and more... and not a single person has looked me in the eyes and told me I deserve more [until this week]. THANK YOU!" Because of you, Rachel now realizes that she has value, and that she can set healthy boundaries for herself.


HELPING MEN AND WOMEN REALIZE HOPEFUL POSSIBILITIES

Have you ever felt scared, lonely and didn't know where to turn? Every day, men and women facing unexpected pregnancies have to make a life-altering decision: abortion, adoption or parenting. Because of you, individuals can visit Clarity's six area pregnancy centers for vital support and resources. During pregnancy, clients receive counseling, pregnancy tests, ultrasounds and adoption referrals. We continue to support parents and families once the baby is born by providing counseling/emotional support, parenting education classes and material assistance.

Men and women visit Clarity's STI Testing Clinic, often stressed and concerned about their risk of infection. With your support, we offer free or low-cost testing and treatment, as well as resources and support. As we build relationships with people, we speak hope into their lives, teaching them how to make healthy choices which reflect their worth.



AMBER'S STORY

Amber* visited our pregnancy center, clearly distraught about her pregnancy and her baby's future. She originally wanted to raise her baby, but realized she would not be able to.

When a woman is pregnant she has several options: to have an abortion, to place her baby in a loving home through adoption, or to carry and parent. When you have many obstacles in your life, all of these options are difficult. We talked to Amber about her options and what each might look like. After much discussion and with tears in her eyes, Amber shared that the best thing she could do for her baby was to make an adoption plan.

We connected Amber with an adoption agency, who lovingly supported her through the rest of her pregnancy. Amber contacted us to share that she chose a faith-centered couple to raise the baby through an open adoption. Amber beamed with pride as she shared photos of the baby and talked about the baby's adoptive parents.

Because of you, Amber realized she could selflessly provide a stable life for her baby by choosing adoption.

SUPPORTING MEN AND WOMEN ON THEIR PATHS TOWARD FREEDOM

Can you imagine carrying the burden of trauma for years and years? This year, there was a 300% increase of people who reached out to Clarity for help addressing past trauma. Because of your generosity, we were able to continue meeting these growing needs through support groups and one-on-one counseling.

Over the past year, Hearts Restored experienced growth and collaboration on an international level. We partnered with Support After Abortion, a healing network which allows other organizations to refer men and women to Hearts Restored. This partnership allowed people from other states and countries to join our groups right away, rather than waiting months for a study to begin near them.

Hearts Restored also continues to expand study topics, so that people can heal from various layers of trauma. Two new studies were added to Hearts Restored this year, *Conquering Codependency* and *Hope After Loss*. In addition, individuals who have gained healing through Hearts Restored studies have stepped up as facilitators to give back and serve those who need restoration.

LIA'S STORY

Lia* returned to her home in Guam, after traveling to another country for a legal abortion. She was devastated by the 2nd trimester procedure. No longer with her boyfriend for support and too ashamed to share with friends, she reached out to Hearts Restored for help. Lia was raised in a Buddhist family and claimed to have no faith, so she asked to join a Hearts Restored study that was not faith-based. But when she heard about God's forgiveness and comfort from a Hearts Restored leader in her group, Lia wanted to know more. Today, Lia has joined a faith-based study for further healing, is asking questions about our faith and is seeking "this beautiful confidence and peace" for herself!





